OSAAT OFFERINGS

PHYSICAL INFRA

Rebuilding dilapidated rural government schools has been the focus OSAAT started with to support education in rural India.

Today, OSAAT is set to cross the 100th school mark as it reaches out to many states other than Karnataka. Adding 9 more states and coordinating with local volunteers and governments, the footprint is now national.



DIGITAL INFRA

Starting with network support in places of poor connectivity with optimum bandwidth to set up a Digital Infra, a dedicated team of ODiSI delivers the Digital Program.

Smart TVs for classrooms, laptops for teachers, shared tabs for students is only a start. ODiSI platform helps the teachers track progress with a dashboard.

Today, as it crosses 75 schools in clusters, ODiSI handholds learners to learn using AI and gamification as well.

POST INTERVENTION

A new offering from the next financial year, is to strengthen our commitment with a dedicated team for post-intervention.

This is to make sure that all the assets created stay in good use, as we also address any other need to help them work towards becoming a self-sustaining model school.

The offering will include setting up libraries with books, shelves and furniture.




HAPPENING - OSAAT'S LARGEST SCHOOL

Masthi at Malur in Kolar, Karnataka is set to become a special milestone for OSAAT. OSAAT's biggest school of 21 classrooms with labs, kitchen and toilet blocks is coming up here. Located inside the premises of KPS Masthi, it will support over 800 students from LKG to 8th standard. The entire project is supported by Thakkar Family Foundation, USA.




Artists' impression of the proposed school, set to be inaugurated in mid 2025!

This has helped in creating aspirational classrooms, hygienic toilet blocks and secure kitchens that add value to the school and pride to the students.


In 2024-25, OSAAT has completed many CSR projects in Telangana, Meghalaya, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand and Karnataka.




NEW AVENUES - ODISI



ODiSI delivery cost for 2024-2025: Rs 4 Lakh per school with around **200 students per school** (ODiSI is deployed for Grades 6 to 10).


